



# QFES Board of Management Communique

October 2016

*The Board of Management (BoM) meets bi-monthly to discuss emerging strategic and organisational risks for the department.*

The QFES Board of Management met on Thursday 13 October 2016 with discussions providing the following items of note:

- Human Resource Information System (HRIS) Project – to transition to DSITIA at a strategic level. QFES will still be involved and accountable for two pieces of work:
  - Changes to the QFES payroll environment as staff transitioned from PSBA are still in the Aurion payroll system and QFES staff are in Lattice.
  - HCM are focussing on ensuring new governance arrangements are in place, and implementation of the new product.
- PSBA Review/QFES Organisational Design – work to finalise the new structure is continuing as a priority with an emphasis on QFES future direction and a continued focus on working together as one department with many services, capabilities and partners.

A number of other matters discussed will be explored further at the next Senior Executive Meeting to be held in December. This will ensure an inclusive approach that is consistent with the QFES future direction.
