What do warnings mean?



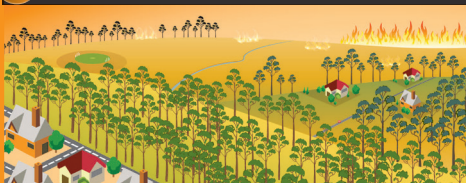
