All Queenslanders should be familiar with the bushfire warnings system. Warnings are issued when there's a bushfire in your area that needs community members to take action.

It's up to you to be aware of what is happening around you. Take notice, seek information, make decisions and act. Always refer to your bushfire survival plan.

Regularly check the official Queensland Fire and Emergency Services website and social media, and tune in to local radio stations.
