## Frequently Asked Questions SES Support Grant Program

- Can I apply if I already have a grant project from a previous round still open?

  Yes. Applications from SES groups that have an existing open grant are eligible to be submitted. These applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the State Assessment Committee (SAC). Page 5 FG.
- What is the maximum amount I can apply for?
  - Facility: QFES can provide up to 75% of the total project cost and up to a maximum of \$75,000 Page 10 FG
  - Vehicle: QFES provides dollar for dollar and up to a maximum of \$30,000 Page 12 FG
- We are unable to co-contribute to the grant project; can I still apply?

  Yes. Co-contribution may be reduced or waived by agreement with QFES. Funding Consideration requests, in writing, for a reduction or waiver will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Page 13 FG.
- Is the grant exclusive of GST? Yes. The grant fund payment is exclusive of GST. Page 8 FG.
- What does the Facility grant allow for?

  The purchase, construction, modification/renovation, extension and/or land for the SES. Page 10 FG
- Seeking a grant for a project which is not a Facility or Vehicle can I still apply?

  Yes. Funding may be available for items that fall outside of these categories in unique circumstances. Requests, in writing, for Special Consideration will be considered on a case-by-case basis. Please also check the SES Major Equipment catalogue. Page 13 FG
- Can I apply for an item already purchased or project already completed?

  No. Grants will not be awarded retrospectively. One of the clearest indicators that funding assistance is not essential is if the project has started or been completed. Page 9 FG
- When can I start the project & when does it have to be completed by?

  Each project round commences on 1 July and is due for completion by 30 June of that financial year

  (eg. 2023-24 round projects start 01/07/2023 & finish 30/06/2024) Page 6 FG
- When will I know if I've won a grant?
   We will advise in writing, regardless of success or otherwise. Outcomes are usually released around March-April.
   Please refer to <u>Key Dates Timelines</u>. <u>Page 6 FG</u>
- If successful, when will I receive the grant funding?

  Grant funds are released upon completion of the grant project and submission of the relevant acquittal form with supporting documentation. <u>Page 18 FG</u>
- Can I change what I want to do with the grant funding?

  You can submit a Variation Request form to request consideration to change project scope. Page 19 FG
- We have delays and we won't meet the completion deadline what do we do? You can submit a Variation Request form to request consideration for an extension of the completion date. This should be submitted at least 1 month prior to your original completion date. Page 19 FG
